8. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COORDINATOR REPORT

(Tana Ross)

Tana Ross provided a sales tax report and sales tax comparison of other cities, and reported that sales tax was up again for this period 4.26%. Mrs. Ross further reported that her contacts alone have almost doubled with realtors and developers and land owners since February. She has spoken with a Starbucks representative this week, two contacts with Dickey's Barbeque, Magnolia Bend Center has over 2800 sq. ft. available, we are waiting on the liquor store and nail salon, and has nine interested in the yellow house.

9. <u>ANNEXATION/ETJ UPDATE</u>

Update of annexation/ETJ proceedings.

Executive Director/City Administrator Paul Mendes reported that he has met with TxDot, Legacy Trust, developers, and he asked Pat Zaiontz, Jeff Chumley and Jonny Williams to sit in on these meetings to look at providing utility service to proposed development. The school board has approved us to use a lift station at the high school which would accommodate the school and proposed development. For water, we would need a 16" main from the City to the intersection and would need to annex. In looking at the properties, we spoke to Canrig and other folks who were less than enthusiastic, so other possibilities were explored. If petitioned for voluntary annexation, we can take almost any size parcel. We have had very productive meetings with owners of parcels that we need to traverse.

President Williams commented that there has been more vandalism at the pavilion.

Mr. Mendes commented that one suggestion he has is to completely fence off the skateboard park with 8 ft. chain link and shut it down with a sign, "Closed temporarily due to vandalism," and to ban bicycles and skateboards to send a message that when they vandalize, they will lose their privileges. The source of the problem seems to stem from the skateboard park. The edges of the bench caps in the pavilion are all scratched

up, scarred up and broken from skateboards sliding against them and bicycles hitting them along the edge of the benches, and then they are taking the broken pieces and throwing them up against the rock wall and knocking out the stacked rock on the columns. The Public Works staff is going to try and repair/replace the damages.
