Economic Development Coordinator Deborah Rose Miller provided the Board with a copy of an international publication, "Texas Wide Open For Business" and emphasized page 91, where the City's ad is featured.

Mrs. Miller reported that sales tax was down 19.98%, but in speaking with the Comptroller, this involves nine energy service providers one of which represents 50% of our loss due to a credit for overpayment last year, and the other 50% is split among the remaining eight providers that range from \$400 - \$2500 less monthly. So it is not about retail. She has requested a detailed confidential report from the State to gather more information.

On October 30th, the Steering Committee for the Comprehensive Plan update is having a major workshop which is expanded to include the Planning Commission, City Council, and 4A and 4B board members are invited.

Mrs. Miller further announced that she has gotten her real estate license. `

a. Unity Park

Executive Director/City Administrator Paul Mendes reported that a couple of weeks ago, the park was reseeded and fertilized, including the barbeque area and portions of the area around The Depot.

b. Downtown Project

Executive Director/City Administrator Paul Mendes reported that he received a second bid to extend 6th Street that came in under \$50,000. As far as repaving 6th Street, that could be taken out of HB445.

c. Economic Development Plan

i. Grow Magnolia

Economic Development Coordinator Deborah Rose Miller reported that regarding our ever increasing ETJ, at last Tuesday's City Council meeting, there were plans to include another 164+ acres but it had to be put on hold due to a snag of a .77 acre tract in the way, but that we are hoping to get their signature and move on. We are only 230 ft. shy of being contiguous and so we already have other property owners in line as an alternative. Next month, her goal is to be beyond that and that by the end of the year, we will have accomplished what our goal is which is to take us out to the spur.

d. Special Events

Economic Development Coordinator Deborah Rose Miller reported that the Stroll Committee held a meeting to set the dates for 2013 events and will be kicking off the new year with a Mardi Gras On The Stroll on February 9th with an umbrella parade going for a Guinness world record which is 1400 umbrellas. Also, a Cajun cookoff is planned. They also recommend that seasonal banners be used to replace the current faded Stroll banners. Mrs. Miller is getting bids for those right now and the Stroll Committee is willing to help with the cost. One banner for Mardi Gras, one for Cork & Canvas, and one for the Texas Renaissance Festival.
