NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

Notice is hereby given that the City of Magnolia will hold a Public Hearing on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 57.15% (*percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of voter-approval tax rate or no-new-revenue tax rate calculated under Chapter 26, Tax Code*). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted.

A public meeting will be held on August 23, 2022 at 7:00 pm at City Hall, 18111 Buddy Riley Blvd., Magnolia, Texas 77354 to consider adoption of the budget and tax rate.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in the City of Magnolia last year was **\$186,268**. Based on last year's tax rate of **\$0.4051** per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was **\$754.57**.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in the City of Magnolia this year is **\$216,923**. If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of **\$0.3813** per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be **\$827.13**.

Members of the public are encouraged to attend the hearings and express their views.

A meeting to consider adopting the budget (if not adopted at this meeting) and tax rate is scheduled for Wednesday, August 24, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

The City of Magnolia will hold a Public Hearing on the proposed Operating Budget for the fiscal year that begins on October 1, 2022 and ends on September 30, 2023. The hearing will be held at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 18111 Buddy Riley Blvd., Magnolia, Texas, on August 23, 2022. All interested parties are invited to attend.

This budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$699,210 which is a 57.15 percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$147,215.

A copy of the proposed budget is on file with the City Secretary for public review and inspection. The City Secretary's office is located at City Hall and is open from 8:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and is also accessible at www.cityofmagnolia.com on the Home page.
