

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CORPORATION COURT  
IN THE TOWN OF MAGNOLIA, MONTGOMERY  
COUNTY, TEXAS, AND DEFINING THE JURISDICTION  
THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the governing body of the Town of Magnolia, Montgomery County, Texas, that a corporation court is hereby created, such corporation court to consist of one corporation judge to be attended by the City Secretary, who shall keep the records thereof, and that such corporation court shall be invested with the powers of enforcement of the various ordinances of the Town of Magnolia by appropriate action as may be hereinafter set forth by the governing body, that the office of Corporate Judge shall be an appointive office by the governing body and the term of office shall be at the will of the governing body.

That should any part of this ordinance be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this ordinance.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after

October 14, 1969
