

ORDINANCE NO. 117
Sesquicentennial Museum

WHEREAS, the State of Texas will celebrate its Sesquicentennial anniversary in 1986; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Magnolia wish to observe this 150th anniversary with celebrations, festivities and special projects of lasting value to the county; and

WHEREAS, a Magnolia Sesquicentennial Museum is being established under the direction of BECKY BAILEY; and

WHEREAS, the City of Magnolia supports the formation and operation of a Magnolia Sesquicentennial Museum; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS:

Section 1. Museum Department Created. The City of Magnolia creates, as an agency of the City and as part of its municipal operations, a Sesquicentennial Museum Department for the purpose of establishing and operating a museum in connection with the City's celebration of the Sesquicentennial of the State of Texas. The department shall be authorized, on behalf of the City, to accept donations and contributions both of space for operation of the museum and of items of historical interest for display in the museum.

Section 2. Term. This department shall remain in operation for a term of one (1) year and eight (8) months commencing May 1, 1985 and ending December 31, 1986.

Section 3. Director. The Director of the Museum Department shall be BECKY BAILEY, who shall be paid one dollar (\$1.00) in each year of operation for her services.

Section 4. Records. The Museum Department shall maintain accurate records of donations and contributions to the museum and shall provide such records and access to records to the Magnolia City Council and City Secretary as may be requested and during regular business hours.
