

ORDINANCE NO. 119

MUNICIPAL COURT RULES AND EXPENSES

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING JUSTICE COURT RULES AS RULES FOR THE MUNICIPAL COURT; AND AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EXPENSE OF \$25.00 FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SERVICE OF A WARRANT OF ARREST.

WHEREAS, in 1983 the Texas Legislature, by Senate Bill No. 1034, authorized a special expense not to exceed \$25.00 for the issuance and service of a warrant of arrest; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an expense of \$25.00 is necessary in order to accomplish service of warrants of arrest; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA:


1. Rules Adopted. The rules of practice and procedure for the Justice Courts of the State of Texas are hereby adopted as the rules of practice and procedure for the municipal court of the City of Magnolia.

2. Warrant Expense. A special expense of \$25.00 for the issuance and service of each warrant of arrest under Section 38.11 of the Texas Penal Code, or under Section 149 of the Texas Uniform Act Regulating Traffic on Highways (Article 6701d, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), or Article 17.04 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure is hereby authorized, which special expense shall be paid into the City Treasury.
