

ORDINANCE NO. 18

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING WHAT NUMBER OF ALDERMEN  
SHALL GO OUT OF OFFICE IN ONE YEAR, AND THE MANNER OF  
DECIDING WHICH SHALL HOLD FOR THE LONG TERM AND  
WHICH FOR THE SHORT TERM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS

SECTION 1. In accordance with Article 979, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, the Mayor and Aldermen shall hold staggered terms of office, so that the Mayor and two Aldermen shall be elected in one year, and the remaining three Aldermen in the following year.

SECTION 2. The Aldermen elected in the election held on the 4 day of April, 1970 having drawn lots, the Mayor and Aldermen Dwain Baker and E R Barton shall hold office until the election to be held in April, 1972 and until their successors in office shall have duly qualified; and Aldermen James Johnson, James Presley and E W Green shall hold office until the election to be held in April, 1971 and until their successors in office shall have duly qualified.

SECTION 3. Beginning with the election to be held in April, 1971, and at all elections thereafter, the Mayor and Aldermen to be elected at any election as their respective terms of office expire as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance shall hold office for a term of two (2) years and until their successors in office shall have duly qualified.
