ORDINANCE NO. 2005-369

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF ENGINE BRAKES (ALSO KNOWN AS "JAKE BRAKES") IN THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS, EXCEPT IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Engine Brakes. This ordinance applies to the use or operation of an auxiliary or compression engine brake (also known as a "jake" brake) which produces any noise in addition to the normal operating engine noise is prohibited within the city limits. This provision is not intended to prohibit the passage of vehicles equipped with engine brakes or "Jake brakes" in posted areas but rather prohibit the use of such equipment in posted areas.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any driver of a truck or truck-tractor to activate or use the unit's engine brake within the city limits except in an emergency situation.

SECTION 3. The term "emergency situation", for the purposes of this ordinance, shall mean one in which there is imminent danger of collision with property, persons or animals.

SECTION 4. Penalty Clause. Any person, or persons, violating or failing to comply with any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined, upon conviction, not less that one dollar (\$1.00), nor more that five hundred (\$500.00) dollars, for each offense.

SECTION 5. Severability Clause. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are separable, and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this Ordinance, since then same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of unconstitutional or invalid phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections.

SECTION 6. The City Secretary shall give notice of the enactment of this Ordinance by publishing it or its descriptive caption and penalty at least one time within ten (10) days after final passage in the official newspaper of the City; the Ordinance to take effect upon publication.
