Ordinance 2006-089

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION ON MAY 13, 2006, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE (3) COUNCILMEMBERS AND THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR, AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY FOUR PROPOSITIONS; (1) TO APPROVE OR REJECT THE DISSOLUTION OF THE MAGNOLIA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION; AND (2) TO APPROVE OR REJECT THE USE OF SALES AND USE TAX PROCEEDS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE RELATING TO WATER SUPPLY FACILITIES AND WATER CONSERVATION PROGRAMS; (3) TO APPROVE OR REJECT ISSUING CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION FOR THE REPAIR OF A WATER WELL AND THE ACQUISITION AND RENOVATION OF THE BUILDING LOCATED AT 18111 BUDDY RILEY BLVD., MAGNOLIA, TEXAS TO BE USED AS THE NEW CITY HALL; (4) TO REAUTHORIZE THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS AT THE RATE OF ONE-FOURTH OF ONE PERCENT; AND DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES AND APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICIALS FOR SUCH ELECTION; PROVIDING THE FORM OF THE BALLOTS AT SUCH ELECTION; DIRECTING THE GIVING OF NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION: AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, a general election was held in the City of Magnolia, Texas, on May 13, 2006, at which election it was submitted to the resident qualified voters of the City for the purpose of electing the following officials of the City:

Office of Mayor (for a two year term to end in May, 2008)

Councilmember, Position No. 1 (for a one year term to end in May, 2007)

Councilmember, Position No. 4 (for a two year term to end in May, 2008)

Councilmember, Position No. 5 (for a two year term to end in May, 2008)

and it was submitted to the resident qualified voters of the City four propositions, for their action

thereon;

(1) To Approve or Reject the Dissolution of the Magnolia Community Development

Corporation;

(2) To Approve or Reject the Use of Sales and Use Tax Proceeds for Infrastructure

Relating to Water Supply Facilities and Water Conservation Programs

(3) To Approve or Reject Issuing Certificates of Obligation for the Repair of a Water Well and the Acquisition and Renovation of the Building Located at 18111 Buddy Riley

Blvd., Magnolia, Texas to be Used as the New City Hall; and

(4) To Reauthorize the Local Sales and Use Tax in the City of Magnolia, Texas at the rate

of one-fourth of one percent.

WHEREAS, said election was duly called; that notice thereof was given in accordance with

law; and said election was duly and legally held in conformity with the election laws of the State of

Texas, and the results of said election have been verified and returned by the proper judges and

clerks and canvassed by the City Council of Magnolia; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be

true and correct.

Dissolution of the City of Magnolia Community Development Corporation, a development corporation created and operating under Section 4B, Article 5190.6, Vernon's Ann. Tex. Civ. St., as amended (The Development Corporation Act of 1979).

Proposition No. 2

The use of sales and use tax proceeds for infrastructure relating to water supply facilities including transmission and distribution lines, well field developments, and ground and elevated storage facilities and to pay for the maintenance and operating costs of such infrastructure, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 4B(a)(2)(D), Article 5190.6 Vernon's Ann. Tex. Civ. St., as amended.

Proposition No. 3

The issuance of \$1,500,000 Certificates of Obligation for the repair of the water well and the acquisition and renovation of a building located at 1811 Buddy Riley Blvd., Magnolia, Texas, to be used as a new city hall, and the cost of professional services incurred in connection therewith, the limited pledge of a subordinate lien on the net revenues of the City of Magnolia's waterworks and sanitary sewer system to secure payment thereof, and the levying of a tax in payment thereof.

For: <u>103</u> Against: <u>54</u> Total Vote: <u>157</u>

Proposition No. 4

The reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Magnolia, Texas at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

For: <u>142</u> Against: <u>25</u> Total Vote: <u>167</u>

Section 3. The election held in and throughout the City of Magnolia, Texas, on the 13th day of May, 2006, which election is more particularly described in the preamble of this ordinance, was duly called and notice thereof was given and the election was held under and in strict conformity with law; that only duly qualified resident electors of the City voted at the election; that due returns of the election have been made by the proper officers; that the election has resulted in the election of the officers set forth above; that the election has resulted favorably to the issuance the certificates of obligation mentioned in Proposition 3; and that a majority of the qualified voters voting in the election have voted in favor of the issuance of the certificates of obligation mentioned in the preamble of this ordinance and the levy of a tax for payment thereof.

<u>Section 4</u>: The City Council of the City is now authorized to issue all of the certificates of obligation described above, and the City Council is authorized to do any and all things necessary and/or convenient in connection therewith.

Section 5: It is hereby officially found and determined that notice of the meeting at which this ordinance is adopted was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, and that such meeting has been open to the public at all times when this ordinance was discussed and acted on.

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
