Ordinance 2006-099

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE TOMBALL MAGNOLIA TRIBUNE AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006 – 2007; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CONTRACT WITH THE CONROE COURIER; DESIGNATING AN ALTERNATE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 52.004 Texas Local Government Code provides as soon as practicable after the beginning of each municipal year, the governing body of the municipality shall contract, as determined by ordinance or resolution, with a public newspaper of the municipality to be the municipality's official newspaper until another newspaper is selected;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Magnolia desires to officially designate the official public newspaper of the City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Magnolia desires to officially designate the secondary official public newspaper of the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Magnolia hereby designates Tomball Magnolia Tribune a public newspaper in and of the City of Magnolia, Montgomery County, Texas, as the official newspaper of said City, the same to continue as such until another is selected, and shall cause to be published therein all ordinances, notices and other matters required by law or by ordinance to be published.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby given authority to contract with Tomball Magnolia Tribune for said newspaper to become the official newspaper of the City of Magnolia.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Magnolia hereby designates Conroe Courier, a public newspaper in and of the City of Magnolia, Montgomery County, Texas, as the alternate official newspaper of said City, the same to continue as such until another is selected, and shall cause to be published therein all ordinances, notices and other matters required by law or by ordinance when Legal Publication deadlines can not be met by the official newspaper of the City.

SECTION 4. Any and all ordinances, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of Magnolia, Texas, whether written or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
