AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION ON MUNICIPAL AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS FOR THE YEAR 2007 AND FOR EACH THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED.

thereas, Section 11.13 of the Tax Code of the State of Texas authorizes taxing units to adopt Residence Homestead exemptions under certain conditions; and

thereas, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Magnolia, Texas to provide a homestead exemption from a portion of the appraised value of residential homesteads located within the boundaries of the City of Magnolia, Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS;

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Magnolia, Texas, does hereby grant a Resident Homestead Exemption from ad valorem taxes of one (1%) percent or a minimum of \$5,000.00 of the appraised value of residential homesteads within the limits of the City of Magnolia, Texas, for the year 2007 and for each year thereafter.

Section 2. The exemptions will be granted and applied as defined by Section 11.13 of the Tax Code of the State of Texas.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
