ORDINANCE No. 2010-176 AMENDING IMPACT FEES FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-136 WHICH ADOPTED THE CITY'S LAND USE ASSUMPTIONS, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN, AND IMPACT FEES FOR WATER AND WASTEWATER FACILITIES PURSUANT TO THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE ANNOTATED §395.001 ET. SEQ; DEFINING CERTAN TERMS; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF SUCH IMPACT FEES; CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; BY REPLACING THE CURRENT EXHIBIT "B" THAT SETS THE AMOUNT OF IMPACT FEES TO BE ASSESSED WITH A NEW EXHIBIT "B".

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Magnolia, Texas (the "City") adopted impact fees for new construction in 1998 and 2003 and 2008;

WHEREAS, the City Council on or about October 13, 2008, adopted Ordinance 2008-136 Amending Impact Fees for New Construction & Adoption of a Land Use Assumptions Map as required by Chapter 395 of the Texas Local Government Code;

WHEREAS Exhibit "B" of Ordinance 2008-136 set the impact fee schedule;

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen circumstances and a downturn in the economy the City Council desires to help promote development in the City of Magnolia and its ETJ and do so by amending the current impact fees for water and sewer by replacing Exhibit "B" of Ordinance 2008-136 with a new Exhibit "B" that sets forth the amended impact fees to be assessed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there has been substantial compliance with the notice provisions of Chapter 395 of the Texas Local Government Code and the City Council has called, given notice of, and conducted a public hearing regarding the amendment of impact fees pursuant to Chapter 395 of the Texas Local Government Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOIA, TEXAS:

Section 1. Findings. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. Amendment of Fees. The amended impact fees to be charged are set out in Amended Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 3. Authorization. The City is authorized to enact this Ordinance in accordance with Chapter 395, Texas Local Government Code, which authorizes and allows cities to enact or impose impact fees (capital recovery fees) and amend such fees on land within their corporate boundaries or extraterritorial jurisdictions, as charges or assessments imposed against new development in order to generate revenue for funding or recouping the costs of capital improvements or facility expansions necessitated by and attributable to such new development.

Section 4. All other provisions and attachments of Ordinance No. 2008-136 remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Severability Clause. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Magnolia, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on the <u>1</u> day of June, 2010.
