

ORDINANCE NO. O-2010-184

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING A SPEED ZONE ALONG UNITY PARK DRIVE BETWEEN ITS INTERSECTIONS WITH NICHOLS SAWMILL ROAD AND CLOYD STREET; PROVIDING A SPEED LIMIT OF FIFTEEN MILES PER HOUR (15 MPH) WITHIN SUCH SPEED ZONE; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS:

Section 1. Speed Zone Established. That Unity Park Drive between its intersections with Nichols Sawmill Road and Cloyd Drive shall have a speed limit of fifteen miles per hour (15 MPH) and no person shall drive or operate a vehicle at a speed in excess of fifteen miles per hour (15 MPH) when signs are in place giving notice of such speed limit:


Section 2. Penalty. Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) or more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. Severability. In event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional and the City Council of the City of Magnolia, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.
