## ORDINANCE NO. 208

AN ORDINANCE ordering an election to be held in the City of Magnolia, Texas, to submit a proposition on the question of the adoption of an additional sales and use tax under the provisions of Section 4B of the Industrial Development Corporation Act; making provision for the conduct of the election and resolving other matters incident and related to such election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Magnolia, Texas hereby finds that an election should be held for the purposes of submitting a proposition on the levy and collection of an additional sales and use tax within the city under the provisions of Sections 4B of Article 5190.6, V.A.T.C.S. (the "Act"); and

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: An election shall be held on the 21th day of January, 1995 in the City of Magnolia, Texas, which date is not less than forty-five (45) days from the date of the adoption hereof, and is a uniform election date pursuant to V.T.C.A. Election Code, Section 41.001, for the purpose of submitting the following measure:

"SHALL the City Council of the City of Magnolia, Texas, be authorized to impose and adopt an additional one-half cent (1/2)sales and use tax within the City for projects authorized by Section 4B, Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, as amended, including parks, auditoriums, learning centers, open space improvements, athletic and exhibition facilities, and other related improvements and for maintenance and operating costs of the publicly owner ad operated projects?"

SECTION 2: Paper Ballots shall be used in this election and for early voting by personal appearance and by mail and each voter shall record his vote by marking with an X in the square beside the provision. Paper ballots shall be prepared in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Election Code so the voters may cast their ballots either "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid measure which shall appear on the ballot substantially as follows:

"THE ADOPTION OF AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF CENT (1/2 ) SALES AND USE TAX FOR PROJECTS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 4B, ARTICLE 5190.6, VERNON'S TEXAS CIVIL STATUTES, AS AMENDED, INCLUDING PARKS, AUDITORIUMS, LEARNING CENTERS, OPEN SPACE IMPROVEMENTS, ATHLETIC AND EXHIBITION FACILITIES, AND OTHER RELATED IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATING COSTS OF THE PUBLICLY OWNED AND OPERATED PROJECTS"

SECTION 3: The City shall be one election precinct for this election and the polling place designed for election precinct and the person hereby appointed to serve ad Presiding Judge and Alternate Presiding Judge for polling pace are shown in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as a part hereof for all purposes.

The presiding Judge shall appoint not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) qualified clerks to serve and assist in holding said election; provided that if the Presiding Judge herein appointed actually serves, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall be one of the clerks.

On election day, the polls shall be open from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

Early voting shall be conducted at the City Secretary's office in the City Hall, 510 Magnolia Blvd., in accordance with the provisions of V.T.C.A., Election Code.

For purposes of processing ballots cast in early voting, the precinct election officers of Election shall also serve as the Early Ballot Board for this election.

SECTION 4: All resident qualified electors of the City hall be permitted to vote at said election, and on the day of the election, such electors shall vote at the polling place designated for the Election Precinct in which they reside. This election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of V.T.C.A., Election Code and V.T.C.A., Tax code, Subchapter E of Chapter 321, and the Act and as may be required by law, all election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.

SECTION 5: A substantial copy of this ordinance shall serve as proper notice of said election. Said notice, including a Spanish translation thereof, shall be posted not later than the 21st day before the election on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meeting of the City Council and shall also be published at least once not earlier than the 30th day nor later than the 10th day before the election in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the City.

SECTION 6: The public importance of this measure and the fact there is an urgent public necessity for the election herein ordered to be held on the next uniform election date in January, 1995 to avoid further delay in settling the important public issues contained in the proposition to be submitted at such election constitute and create an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public business, property, health or safety, or providing for the usual daily operation of municipal department, and this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in full force and effect from and after the date shown below following its passage and adoption.
