

ORDINANCE # 257

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #239, AND ORDINANCE #242 WHICH AMENDED ORDINANCE #228, AND ESTABLISHING A COMMERCIAL RATE FOR NATURAL GAS TAP FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 2.02 of Ordinance 239, 242 which amended Ordinance 228 is amended to read as follows:

2.02 Tap Fees:

A Tap fee for installing a meter to measure the amount of natural gas delivered to a residential customer shall be assessed. That fee is initially set at \$450.00, which may be amended from time to time by Council.

A Tap fee for installing a meter to measure the amount of natural gas delivered to a commercial customer shall be assessed. That fee is set at the following amounts:

0 to 275,000 BTUs	\$660.00
275,000 to 415,000 BTUs	922.00
415,000 to 1,750,000 BTUs	1,575.00
1,750,000 to 3,300,000 BTUs	396.00 PLUS MATERIALS

All other provisions of Ordinance 239, which amended Ordinance 228 remain intact and viable.
