

CONSTRUCTION SPEED ZONE ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS DURING CONSTRUCTION ON A PORTION OF FM 1488 WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF MAGNOLIA AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation has made it known to the City of Magnolia that operations will begin in the near future to improve FM 1488 by doing base repairs, level up base, and surfacing, and,

WHEREAS, in the interest of safety, it is desirable to maintain a construction speed zone during the construction period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA that a construction speed zone be established along FM 1488 from a point 528 feet west of FM 1774 and extending eastwardly to the Magnolia east city limit, excluding the portion of roadway outside the corporate limits from Magnolia-Conroe Road to Roy Street, for a net distance of 1.302 miles; also, along FM 1774 from the intersection of FM 1488 to a point 528 feet north of FM 1488, a distance of approximately 0.100 mile, 35 MPH, to be effective when so signed within said zone.

Necessary signs for posting the speed zones will be furnished, installed, and maintained by the direction of the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation engineer in charge of the project.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200).

This ordinance shall be in effect only during the period of construction, and completion of this project shall automatically cancel the speed zones.
