**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MAGNOLIA, TEXAS, CONTINUING LOCAL STATE OF
DISASTER.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA,
TEXAS:**

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2011, the Mayor issued a proclamation declaring a
state of disaster for the City of Magnolia, Texas resulting from

a widespread wildfire

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster
continue to exist; and

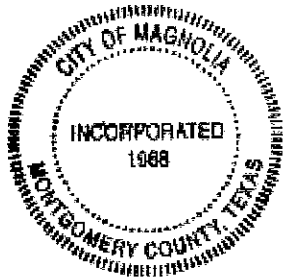
WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local
state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the
consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
MAGNOLIA, TEXAS:**

1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the City of Magnolia by the Mayor on
this day of September 5, 2011, shall continue until terminated by ordinance of
the City Council.
2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to local
authority for emergency measures and shall become effective on the 12th day
of September 2011.

PASSED AND ADOPTED, this 12th day of September 2011.


