ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY NO. 0-2012-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **INCLUDING** THE **HEREINAFTER** MAGNOLIA. TEXAS. DESCRIBED TERRITORY TO THE EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF CITY OF MAGNOLIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS, AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION SO AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY, AND GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS OF SAID PROPERTY ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF OTHER CITIZENS AND BINDING SAID INHABITANTS BY ALL OF THE ACTS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY THAT MAY APPLY WITHIN THE EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION.

WHEREAS, (§42.022 of the Texas Local Government Code and/or Charter) of the City of Magnolia, Texas, an incorporated city, authorizes the expansion of extraterritorial jurisdiction, subject to the laws of this state.

WHEREAS, the procedures prescribed by the (Texas Local Government Code and/or Charter) of the City of Magnolia, Texas, and the laws of this state have been duly followed with respect to the following described territory, to wit:



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL (OR COMMISSION) OF THE CITY OF MAGNOLIA, TEXAS:

That the heretofore described property is hereby included in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Magnolia, Montgomery County, Texas, and that the boundary limits of the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Magnolia be and the same are hereby extended to include the above described territory, and the same shall hereafter be included within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of said city, and the inhabitants thereof shall hereafter be entitled to all the rights and privileges of other citizens of the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Magnolia and they shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of said city that may apply within the extraterritorial jurisdiction.

The City Secretary) is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Montgomery County, Texas, a certified copy of this ordinance.
